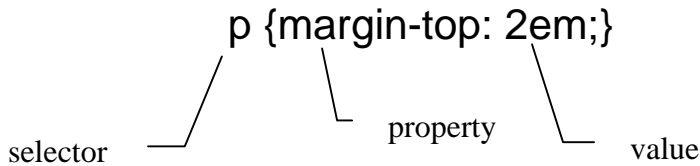


## CSS: The Syntax of a Style . . . for *internal* or *external* stylesheets



### Combining Several Definitions:

*Note: The following two examples show the same style constructed in different manners. The final semicolon in a declaration is not mandatory.*

```
body {font-size: 10pt; font-family: Verdana, 'Myriad Web', sans-serif; color: black;
margin-left: 11%; margin-right: 8%; margin-bottom: 1.5em;}
```

```

  margin-left: 11%;
  margin-right: 8%;
  margin-bottom: 1.5em;
}
```

### Combining Selectors:

```
h1, h2, h3 {font-family: Times, serif; color: blue;}
```

### Independent Class:

```
.menu {font-family: Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif; text-align: center;}
```

### Dependent Class:

```
p.menu {font-family: Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif; text-align: center;}
```

### ID:

```
#makebig { font-family: Arial, Helvetica, sans-serif; font-size: 120px;}
```
