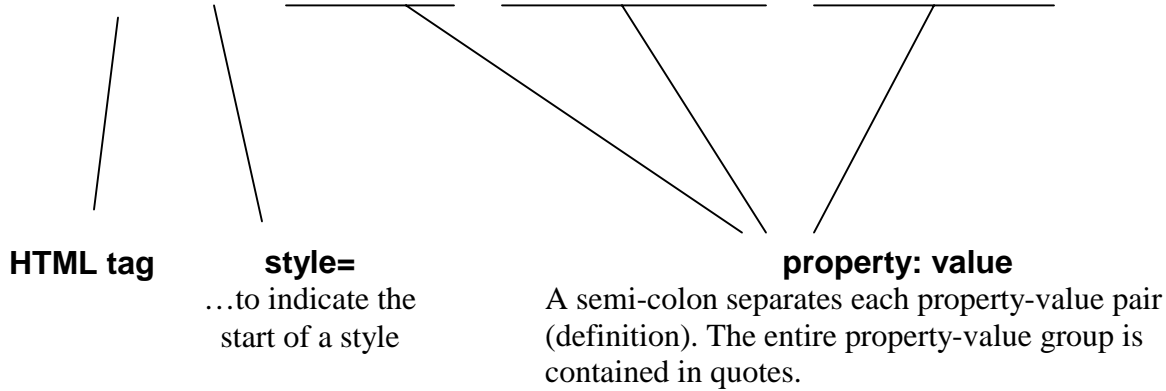


CSS: The Syntax of a Style . . . for *inline* styles

`<div>` = block-level tag

`` = inline tag
